

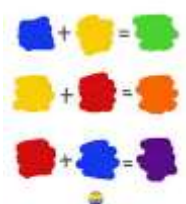
## Science

## Maths

# 20

This half term we are looking at the place value and composition of numbers up to 20. The children will begin looking at tens and ones, one more, one less and doubling numbers as well as putting them into order.

We will then move on to adding and subtracting numbers within 20.

## English

Our main texts this half term will support our *Glorious Ghana* topic: *The Leopard's Drum* and *Handa's Surprise*.



We will also be reading poetry, factual books. The main focus this half term for the Year 1 children will be sequencing sentences to write short stories and using the conjunction 'and' in their writing.

## Geography



We will be focussing on the country Ghana. We will learn how this country compares to England. We will also learn to name the continents of the world.



In RE we will begin our new unit '*Who is Jewish and what do they believe?*' We will explore precious artefacts and listen to key stories.
